The Southern New Jersey Continuum of Care (SNJCoC) is an association of county-wide homelessness Continuums of Care that provides information, services and advocacy for and on behalf of the homeless population in the area of service within the participating Southern NJ Counties (Camden, Cape May, Cumberland and Gloucester). The mission of the Southern New Jersey Continuum of Care is to work to prevent and end homelessness through a public and private collaboration that maximizes efforts and leverages resources.

Applications for NEW PROJECTS FOR COORDINATED ASSESSMENT will be accepted from eligible organizations interested in applying for **2017 HUD funding** to provide coordinated supportive services. A Review Committee will evaluate proposals based on objective performance criteria, local needs and priorities, and make recommendations to the SNJCoC Executive Board on the prioritization of these funds. The Committee reserves the right to request additional information as needed.

A Pre-bid Meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 25, 2017 at 11:30 am at CPAC, 2500 McClellan Avenue, Suite 160, Pennsauken, NJ 08109.
